As a contracted Tutor for DYMON's afterschool program, you will provide targeted academic support in small group or one-on-one settings. Your primary role is to assist middle school students in strengthening their understanding of core subject areas—particularly math, reading, writing, and science—while building confidence and academic independence.

This opportunity is ideal for current or former educators who are passionate about youth success and able to provide structured, responsive, and culturally aware tutoring support. Tutors serve as a key part of the student's support system and help reinforce what is taught during the school day.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide academic tutoring and homework assistance in core subject areas (math, reading, writing, science) aligned with school standards.
- Foster a guiet, focused, and engaging learning environment tailored to student needs.
- Utilize effective instructional strategies to meet students' individual learning styles and academic levels.
- Track and report on student progress, challenges, and milestones.
- Collaborate with Site Coordinators to ensure consistency and alignment with broader program goals.
- Ensure a safe, respectful tutoring space in compliance with DYMON, CDC, and MNPS safety protocols.
- Be prepared to deliver tutoring virtually if required.

- Attend required orientation or in-service training related to your role.
